How Much Does The Course Cost?

The two-month (6 lessons) course costs R1 360.00 per puppy plus a R185.00 enrolment fee, which includes a comprehensive Puppy Owner's Guide and a treat bag. A 25% discount applies to any simultaneous enrolment/s from the same household during the same period (not applicable to enrolment fee).

Puppies should start at 10 - 14 weeks old - exception might be made for small breeds on the upper limit

Pups MUST have had two vaccinations (latest from vet) before starting classes

What Do I Need To Bring?

- Puppy wearing a normal flat buckle collar
- Light webbing lead (no chain or extendable leads please)
- Small, soft easily consumed treats.
 We also sell a range of suitable treats at classes
- Comfortable flat shoes and a hat in warm weather

What Is Covered In The Lessons?

Pups learn how to walk on a lead, sit, lie down, puppy stay, food manners and "calm on cue". Pups also get to socialise in a controlled manner and owners are shown how to address normal puppy problems. A variety of safe yet stimulating puppy "obstacle courses" also help develop co-ordination and enhance obedience. We also provide the pups with exposure to multiple novel items to increase their sensory reference base, which has been proven to increase sociability and confidence when adult.

TERMS & CONDITIONS V7-23

Welcome to McKaynine! Our terms and conditions are largely set up to ensure safety for all dogs and handlers. Please ensure that you have read and are conversant with them.

Parking

- Please park in the designated spots (bottom of the field at Honeydew training grounds).
- Please reduce your speed when in the training grounds and be aware of the possibility of children and off lead dogs.

Leads

- ALL puppies and dogs are to be on lead at ALL times unless instructed otherwise by an instructor or assistant.
- Please ensure that your lead is of a suitable quality and not likely to break. If you are unsure, please ask an instructor or assistant.
- Excessively long leads, chain leads and retractable leads are discouraged. A suitable lead is leather or webbing 90cm 120cm length.

Collars/Chains

- ALL puppies and dogs are to be wearing a collar/half-check/harness at ALL times unless instructed otherwise by an instructor or assistant.
- Please ensure that your collar/half-check/harness is of a suitable quality and not likely to break. If you are unsure, please ask an instructor or assistant.
- Prong collars and electric shock collars are NOT allowed. Half-check collars for puppies are permitted, but a normal collar is preferred.

Training Equipment

- Under NO circumstances are puppies or dogs allowed on any of the training equipment/obstacles unless under the direct supervision of an instructor or assistant.
- Please ensure that children attending the classes are made aware that none of the training equipment is to be played upon/with.

General

- Control of your dog remains your responsibility at all times. Please prevent your dog from creating a disturbance or provoking other dogs.
- Only able-bodied adults are permitted to handle dogs unless prior arrangement has been made with management.
- Please ensure that any mess your dog makes is cleaned up as soon as possible we request that you bring your own plastic bags to training for this purpose. Should you forget, we do have bags available.
- Please ensure that your puppy or dog is suitably protected against ticks and fleas at all times.
- Dogs that are ill, injured or on heat are not permitted to attend classes. We are unable to offer a refund for lessons missed in this regard owner/handlers are however welcome to attend to keep up with class content. If you have any doubt, please inform the instructor before coming to class.
- Please refrain from smoking, eating and drinking during classes and please use the rubbish bins and ashtrays provided.
- Children attending classes are required to be supervised by an adult at all times we strongly advise that this adult is additional to the person handling the puppy/dog.
- Dogs not enrolled in classes are not allowed on the premises (exception of instructor's and assistant's dogs refer next section).
- Vaccinations must be current and administered by a licenced veterinarian on an official practice card detailing vaccine batch numbers.

Benching/Crating of Dogs

- Dogs are NOT to be benched i.e. tied to a pole they must rather be crated.
- Please crate your dogs in a shaded area. If your dog is to remain in your car, please ensure that the car is shaded and that there is no doubt as to the comfort and wellbeing of the dog.
- Should your dog bark or whine excessively when they are crated, please make alternate arrangements.

Interaction with other dogs and people

- No on-lead socialising! Please respect the personal space of other dogs and puppies do not allow your puppy or dog to barge into another puppy or dog's space. Repeated incidents will result in non-admission with no refund of fees paid.
- Please exercise good sense around crated dogs.
- Please do NOT feed another person's puppy or dog without asking permission first. Should you be denied permission please do not be offended. Teaching a dog to accept food from a stranger is a very bad habit and there might be allergy concerns.

Adverse Weather/Class Rescheduling

- In most cases we have undercover areas, so in adverse weather classes go ahead UNLESS we contact you to the contrary to reschedule a lesson.
- In exceptional situations the dates and times of classes are subject to change, due to circumstances beyond our control. In such cases we will do our utmost to accommodate handler's needs.

Cancellation Policy, Refund & Notice Structure

Course cancellation more than 7 days prior to start of course 100% Course cancellation less than 7 days prior to start of course

Private lessons cancelled within 24 hours of the scheduled time will be charged at 100% - no exceptions

A cancellation is deemed as any change to the originally booked dates, times or location, with written notice from the client. Lessons elapsed prior to notice cannot be refunded. Lessons not attended due to client's scheduling/circumstances or dog illness/heat cycles cannot be refunded. We will do our utmost to accommodate circumstances outside of the client's control but are limited in this respect as we are unable to fill spaces in classes once the course has commenced. On-going monthly classes are billed and payable until such time that client advises non-attendance in the month before this occurs. We cannot credit billing in arrears.

Missed Lessons

We cannot offer make-up lessons for lessons missed by the client – in this instance we will do our utmost to assist the client in catching up during the remaining lessons.


